Michael Adler is head of Corporate & Investment Banking USA (CIB), which includes employees from BBVA USA, BBVA New York, and BBVA Securities Inc. In September 2016, Adler was appointed to his current position.

He has extensive experience in building and leading multi-strategy lending businesses, distressed asset resolution, structured equity investing, specialty lending and corporate Finance.
